Bur aim is to give students the opportunity to spark a passion for dance and also build lifelong memories and friendships.





Dive into the dazzling universe of aerial arts! Our classes are a ticket to the sky, featuring silks, lyra (hoop) trapeze, and straps! Get ready to strike jaw-dropping poses in mid-air, spin, and if you're feeling adventurous, learn some heart-stopping drops! Soar safely with our instructors guiding you through the art of flying!

This genre combines dance techniques with acrobatics using unique choreography which seamlessly blends artistic dance movement and tricks together. Students will learn tricks, tumbles, limbers and basic contortion in a safe environment. Modern partnering techniques are also incorporated into acro classes.

jazz & hip hop

Get ready to groove in a lively class packed with the hottest tunes and a vibe that'll make you want to dance! We kick things off with some age-appropriate warm-ups to pump up those muscles, followed by stretching to keep everyone limber. Expect to strut your stuff with travelling moves, centre combinations, awesome leaps, turns, and routines that'll have you dancing like nobody's watching!

Tap your toes to the beat with the Glenn Wood Tap syllabus! Dancers groove through a delightful lineup of tap steps, adding on trickier combos as they level up their skills. It's like a dance party for your brain, boosting your musicality, timing, and balance—all while having a blast!

classical ballet

Students will gain a practical dance education in ballet, progressively developing technical, musical and performance skills. Dancing en pointe is the most advanced form of classical ballet and therefore, can only be taught to and performed by selected students. It is the decision of LCDA team members to inform students when they are eligible for pointe.

intemporary & grical

Students will learn to use the body's natural lines and energy to create new movements, which have a greater range and fluidity. Our contemporary/lyrical class is well structured and incorporates relaxation, suspension, falling, floor work, jumps and travelling sequences.

performance l'exam opportunities

Examinations are offered under the Comdance Modern Jazz and Ballet, Glenn Wood Tap, Aerial Arts and the Acrobatic Arts syllabus. Exams are designed to encourage, motivate and reward students, with their progressive structure. It is the directors decision if a student is ready to sit for an examination - participation is by invitation only. Invitations are sent via email to join our Performance team. Participation in our End Of Year Concert is not compulsory but is highly encouraged.

### **INVOICING STRUCTURE**

Our fees are calculated based on a comprehensive annual amount, accounting for all public and school holidays. This total is then divided into four equal installments, which are invoiced prior to each term. Please note that a 10% late fee will be applied to any overdue payments, and refunds are not available.

### **AUTO PAY**

Enroll in Auto Pay for a convenient "Set and Forget" experience. Once set up, the invoice amount will be automatically deducted prior to the due date.

### PAYMENT PLANS

## policies and procedures

- Fees are calculated annually, and invoices will be issued for quarterly installments. Payments must be made within 14 days of receiving the invoice to avoid a 10% late fee.
- Payments can be made via Credit/Debit card through the LCDA Portal.
- Families can receive a discount on term fees: 10% for participating in three or more classes per week, 15% for participating in ten or more classes per week
- While children are not participating in dance classes, children remain the responsibility of parents/caregivers at all times. No supervision is supplied by LCDA outside of class time in which students are enrolled.
- Please be cautious on the driveways around the studios. Please no standing on the roads.
- Photography and videos will be taken during classes for social media use. If you prefer your child not to be included in these, please ensure the media release on your enrolment reflects this preference.
- La Crème Dance Academy operates as a paperless business, with all communications and invoicing conducted via email or the LCDA Portal.
- Security Cameras are present in the Nanango & Kingaroy Studios view our Security & Livestreaming policy on our website for more information.
- The director will determine if a student is ready to take an examination or be selected for the performance team. Invitations for examinations, Eisteddfods, and Assistant Teaching roles will be extended to students at the directors discretion.
- For any routine choreographed by LCDA staff, dancers must seek approval from the director before performing it at any event or competition, regardless of their enrolment status. TERMINATION OF ENROLMENT:
- - You may terminate your enrolment before the Term ends if you are sick, incapacitated, or bankrupt. A current certificate from a qualified medical practitioner must be provided, confirming your inability to utilize our services due to permanent illness or physical incapacity, or evidence of bankruptcy from the Australian Financial Security Authority.
  - You may also terminate your enrolment before the Term ends if all current fees have been paid.
  - LCDA reserves the right to terminate or refuse enrolment under certain circumstances, including but not limited to: involvement in illegal, dishonest, or fraudulent activities; providing false or misleading information or representations; exhibiting hostile, abusive, or aggressive behavior toward any staff, parent, guardian, caregiver, or student; behaving unruly on the premises; or refusing to follow reasonable instructions from LCDA staff. If termination occurs under these conditions, LCDA will refund the remaining proportion of fees paid for the current term, where appropriate.

### PARENTS & GUARDIANS

To ensure that students gain the full benefits of their learning experiences, parents and guardians are kindly asked to refrain from attending classes. However, at the end of the term we hold a watching week in which parents & family are invited to observe classes. For those who wish to remain at the studio, a waiting room is provided.

Please remember that a quiet environment enhances learning. For younger children who are just beginning, parents are encouraged to bring their children into the room to introduce them to the teacher and fellow students.

Parents should also be aware that in this industry, physical contact with the child is often necessary during class, whether by the teacher, assistant, or another student. Corrections from the teacher or assistant will involve handson guidance.

Students who take breaks between classes will not be supervised by LCDA staff. While the waiting area is available, please note that students will not receive supervision during this time.



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
